






Drivers of Employment Growth

Over the ten years ending 2024, employment in Manufacturing for McPherson County, Kansas added 1,318 jobs. After adjusting for national growth during this period and industry mix share, the part of this employment change due to local competitiveness was a gain of 1,164 jobs—meaning this industry was more competitive than its national counterpart during this period.










Living Guide

How it Worked:


- Ads were used to promote free living guide to entice people to provide their email address




